

Conceptual framework

Peaceful use non-military use vs. non-aggressive use

Military use \rightarrow weaponization, military operations


passive military use \rightarrow militarization

surveillance
intelligence
early warning
global positioning
navigation
communication
Earth observation

≠ use of military personnel, equipment or facilities for peaceful purposes

Dual-use civilian and military use or usability

Space weapon universally accepted definition not available, various classifications




